## OVERVIEW:

- Isolated severe thunderstorms with damaging wind gusts are possible this afternoon mainly east of the Blue Ridge Mountains.
- A slow moving cold front will approach the area this weekend and eventually move through the area early next week. This front may bring multiple hazards from severe thunderstorms to flash flooding. High heat indices are also possible Saturday afternoon.

Locally heavy rainfall with isolated incidents of flooding is also possible Sunday and/or Sunday night. High heat indices of 100 to 105 are possible Saturday afternoon.</li></ul>
